

Thank you for participating in Sprint for Seals!

By taking part, you are supporting the vital work of the Cornish Seal Sanctuary, where vulnerable rescued seal pups receive the expert care they need.

All proceeds raised through Sprint for Seals 2019 will go towards our work rescuing, rehabilitating, and releasing seal pups around the coast, as well as caring for those who sadly cannot be released. The winter season 2017/18 was our busiest season yet, seeing us rehabilitate nearly 90 pups! So far, the 2018/19 one has been extremely busy too with well over 60 pups coming through the hospital by mid-January.

It costs the Sanctuary an average of £2,000 to fully rehabilitate a rescued seal pup, so every penny raised

makes a real difference, especially for pups like Ted, who had a broken jaw that had to be rewired or Harry who needed extra care due to becoming entangled in ocean litter.

Harry was rescued early in 2018. He had become entangled in netting, which was wrapped around his neck and body, causing life threatening injuries. He was brought to the Cornish Seal Sanctuary and given the best possible care from both our team and the specialist vets. After months of care, he was successfully released back out into the wild.

To fundraise through Sprint for Seals, you can collect donations either online or using a sponsor form – or both.

To fundraise online, set up a page through JustGiving:

You simply need to click on the 'Start Fundraising' button on the right of the page. If you are not already registered, you will need to register with JustGiving to set up an online fundraising page. Tell your friends, family, colleagues, about your fundraising – you can email them the link to your online page, and share it on your social media channels.

Here are some examples of how your fundraising helps:

£10 could buy a bottle for feeding rescued seal pups.

£20 could provide essential vitamins for the seals.

£50 could pay for a full vet visit for rescued seal pups.



£100 could feed the rescued seal pups in the Sanctuary's seal hospital for 5 days.

Before the day

Please fill in all the attached form with this pack. You will need to bring this in, fully completed, on the day. Any runners who do not bring the completed form with them will **not** be allowed to participate. Please be aware that the run will take you around the sanctuary, including some bumpy estuary tracks, steps, steep gradients and through the woods (see below map for further details). These areas could be slippery or muddy, so please take care. Health and safety is paramount, so if you have any questions or issues, please give the sanctuary team a call on 01326 221361 for further help or information.

On the day

Please ensure that you wear weather-appropriate clothing and footwear that is safe, comfortable and appropriate for the activity.

We will be providing some water, however in the interest of being as environmentally friendly as possible; we request that runners please bring their own water in reusable bottle to help reduce the amount of waste.

How to find us:

The Cornish Seal Sanctuary is located in Gweek Village. There are a variety of ways to get to the Cornish Seal Sanctuary, however we do recommend reaching us by car. Take the A3083 from Helston and turn onto the B3293 at the roundabout and follow the brown signs to the Cornish Seal Sanctuary. You can get the 35A bus from Helston, however please check out bus times before travelling as buses are not very regular.

We have copious parking available at the sanctuary, however it is steep so please leave your car in gear and check your handbrake. There is disabled parking available directly outside the sanctuary reception. If you have any special parking requirements, please contact us prior to the day on 01326 221361.

Registration will open at 8.30am at the Cornish Seal Sanctuary reception. Please bring along all your forms in order to register. You will be issued with your exclusive running number and will need to write your emergency contact information on it, so please have this to hand.

You are more than welcome to bring your dog with you; they can participate too! Please be aware that all dogs must be kept on leads at all times. There are bins and water bowls situated around site. Spectators are more than welcome to come along! There will be an area for spectators at the start and finish point of the run to cheer you on. If spectators wish to enter the sanctuary, the usual fees will apply.

The run will begin at 9.30am. Please arrive no later than 15 minutes prior to the start of the run, to allow sufficient time for registration. There will be marshals and first aiders situated around the course. Please ensure that if you have any issues, you speak with one of them as soon as possible.

After the run
